WSET Level 1 Award in Wines

For individuals new to wine study, this qualification provides a hands-on introduction to the world of wine. You'll explore the main types and styles of wine through sight, smell, and taste, while also gaining the basic skills to describe wines accurately and make food and wine pairings. Upon successful completion, you will receive a WSET certificate and lapel pin.

This qualification has a minimum requirement of six hours of study time.

Assessment is by a closed-book exam of 30 multiple-choice questions.

Each class lasts 2.5 hours and involves a tutored tasting of six exemplary wines.

WSET Level 2 Award in Wines

Gain an understanding of the world's principal and regionally important grape varieties, the regions where they are grown, and the styles of wine they produce.

You'll explore the factors that impact style and quality and learn how to describe these wines with confidence.

Delivery and assessment This qualification has a minimum requirement of 28 hours of study time, including 16 hours of classroom or online delivery time. Assessment is by a closed-book exam of 50 multiple choice questions.

Each class lasts 2 hours and involves a tutored tasting of six exemplary wines.

WSET Level 3 Award in Wines

Build your knowledge and gain an advanced understanding of grape growing and winemaking.

Upon completion you will be able to assess wines accurately and use your understanding to explain style and quality with confidence.

Delivery and assessment This qualification has a minimum requirement of 84 hours of study time, including 30 hours of classroom or online delivery time. Assessment is by 50 multiple choice questions, a paper of short written answers and a blind tasting of two wines.

Each class lasts 2.5 hours and involves a tutored tasting of six exemplary wines.
